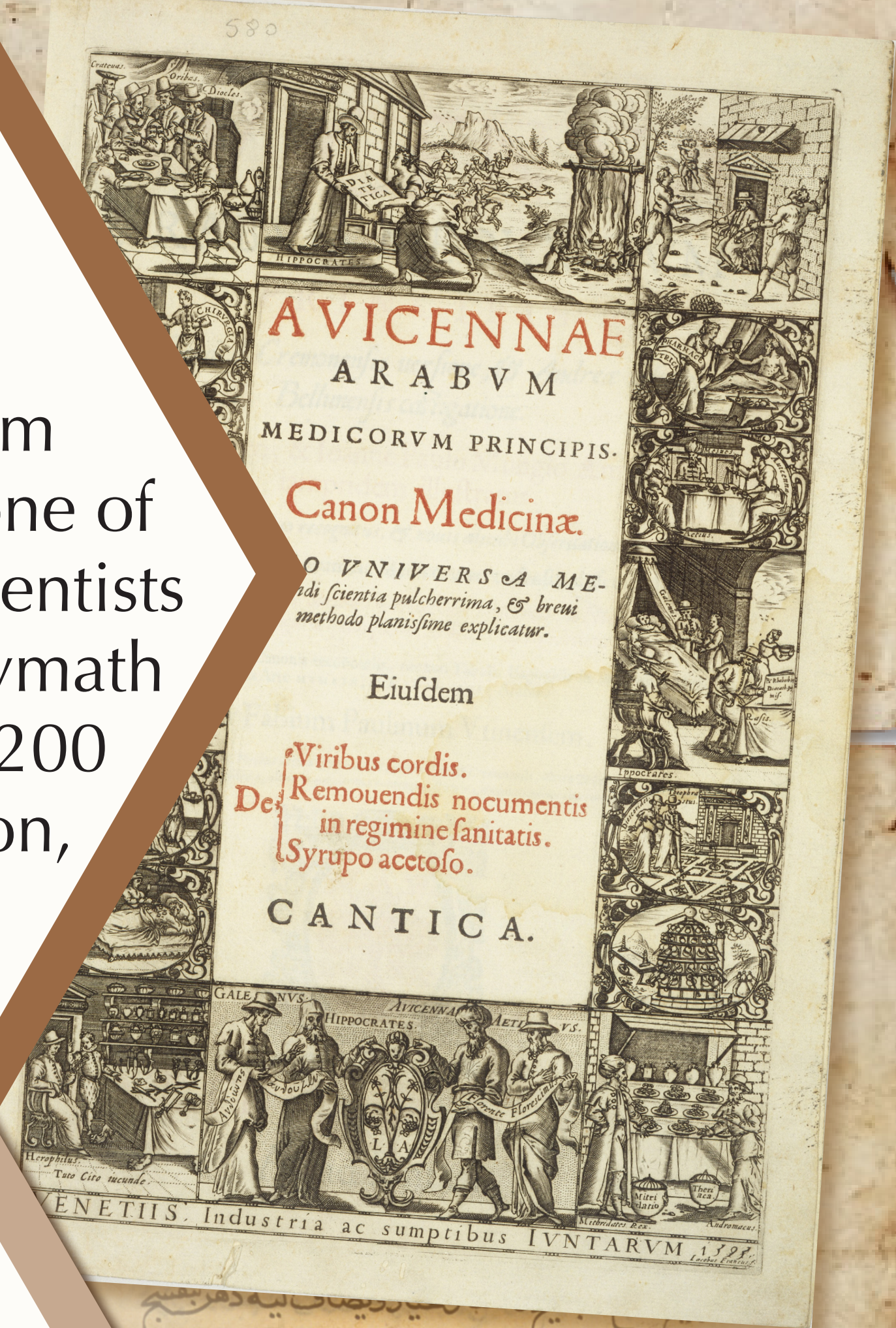

the most eminent Muslim scholars in medicine and one of the most famous Muslim scientists in the world. He was a polymath and the author of almost 200 books on science, religion, and philosophy.



Avicenna

is famous for his book "Al-Qanun Fi-Tibb" which means the law of Medicine, commonly known as "The Canon". It is a 14-volume book which classifies and describes diseases, and outlines their assumed causes. It was translated to different languages and was a standard medical text in Europe for seven centuries (until early eighteenth century). In 1973, Avicenna's "Canon of Medicine" was reprinted in New York.
